



First, I'd like to thank all of you for contributing to the success of our breakfast. From selling tickets and flipping pancakes to picking up donations and setting up / cleaning up - every job was important, and everyone pitched in to make this a breakfast we can be proud of! I'm sure everyone's wondering "how'd we do?". Well, the results are still coming in because we haven't collected everyone's ticket sales yet, but EARLY totals show:

- We served nearly **600 Breakfasts** on Saturday
- The pack has made **OVER \$5,000** in profit!!!
- Our Service Project was a terrific success.
  - We collected **51 blankets** for Crossroads
  - We also donated our left-over food, including sausage, milk, orange juice, butter and bananas to Crossroads
